# Item No.9.1: To Confirm Minutes of the Eighth Meeting of the Academic Council held on 15th October, 2019.

The Member Secretary to the Academic Council presented the minutes of the 8th meeting of the Academic Council held on 15th October, 2019 which was circulated to members and apprised the members on the action taken / status on the decisions taken on the report. The members considered the minutes and after discussions confirmed the same unanimously (Annexure-1).

The Member Secretary also apprised the Academic Council about the conduct of Pavas Semester Examination 2019, already conducted at University level at 28 different centers in Jan. 2020. The university adopted a paperless system for paper setting, answer book appraisal, etc. The Member Secretary further informed that the Integrated University Management System provided by M/s ITI Limited helped university in automation of various processes of the examination.

The Academic Council appreciated the efforts of the Vice Chancellor and his team for conducting the examination in a smooth and systematic manner.

The Academic Council placed on record the dedicated efforts of the Vice Chancellor and his team in bringing up the University to the present level in such a short span of two years.

The Member Secretary further informed the Academic Council that the Basant Semester teaching has already started at affiliated institutes and the examination will commence from June 1, 2020. He solicited the co-operation and support of the Deans for providing the syllabi at the earliest.

# Item No.9.2: Approval of award of Certificate and Diploma based on Semester Examinations held in 2018-19.

The Members after discussions, passed the grace and approved award of Certificate and Diploma based on Semester Examinations held in Academic Year 2018-19.

# Item No.9.3: Constitution of a Committee for bilingual drafting the format of Certificate, Diploma and Degree to be conferred in the First Convocation

The Member Secretary informed the Academic Council that since the University plans to have its first Convocation during March-April, 2020, there is an urgent need of drafting and designing the certificates both in Hindi and in English for which the approval of the Academic Council is also mandatory before getting the same printed. Every such Certificate and Diploma shall have a unique ID using which same can be verified by anyone on University website.

# Item No.9.4: Approval of Syllabi for Basant Semester 2020 published on website and submitted and recommended by respective Board of Studies - Authorization to the Vice Chancellor.

The Member Secretary expressed gratitude and thanks to the Deans for their co-operation and dedication extended in all areas, especially in finalization of the Syllabus. He informed that the Syllabus for Basant Semester 2020 has already been uploaded in the website of the University. In this regard the Member Secretary requested the members to authorize

the Vice Chancellor to approve all syllabi including those are pending for finalization with the Board of Studies and as such will be uploaded later on the website.

The members, after discussions, authorized the Vice Chancellor of the University to consider and approve the syllabi pertaining to the Basant Semester 2020 as per recommendations of the BoS.

# Item No.9.5: Approval of Exemption from General Courses to the students having obtained General Degree (Annexure-III).

The Academic Council considered the proposal.

After detailed discussions, the Academic Council approved exemption from General Credits requirement in their respective courses to students listed in Annexure III, on the basis of their having obtained general degree students from National and International Academic Institutions, Universities, Corporate Certifying Agencies of repute, as per Rule 135 of CBCS Regulations.

The Member Secretary explained present status of languages and communication skills presently available with the University and also explained need for additions of various Indian and foreign languages in the arena of Language and Communication Skills.



Further, the Academic Council, after detailed deliberations, approved the launch of new Two Year M. Des courses (NSQF level9) in the Faculty of Fashion Design, Faculty of Product Design and faculty of Communication Design. The entry level will be B. Des with the same discipline.

Details and necessary amendment in regulations will be placed in the next meeting of Academic Council.

### Item No.9.12: Considering the proposal to introduce PG Diploma in Yoga from Academic Session 2020-21

The Academic Council considered the proposal to introduce PG Diploma in Yoga (NSQF Level 8) from Academic Session 2020-21 and after discussions, in view of the scope for employment opportunities, approved the proposal to introduce PG Diploma in Yoga from Academic Session 2020-21. The entry level will be Bachelor Degree in any discipline. Details and necessary amendment in regulations will be placed in the next meeting of Academic Council.

# Item No.9.13: Approval of courses for session 2020-21 and authorization to Vice Chancellor, RISU for adding new courses in the list of 2019-20.

The Academic Council after discussions on the subject authorized the Vice Chancellor to add new courses in the list of courses for Academic Session 2019-20 for academic year 2020-21.

### Item No.9.14: Approval of affiliation and other fees for concurrent courses as per recommendation by Finance Committee

The Member Secretary apprised the Academic Council about the decision taken by the Finance Committee of the RISU at their meeting held on 15th October, 2019 with

regard to affiliation and other fees for concurrent courses. The Finance Committee recommended charging of 60% of the normal fee for affiliation, examination, enrolment, development, etc. from the institutes/ students availing the facility of concurrent courses.

The Academic Council after detailed deliberations approved the recommendations of the Finance Committee with regard to affiliation and other fees for concurrent courses as 60% of the normal fees as being charged from individual institutions under the Affiliation Rules 2017 of RISU. Amendments to this effect be made in Rule 419, Chapter VI, in Regulation for Award of Skill Credit Certificates.

However, the application fee, processing fee and inspection fee shall remain at par with regular courses.

# Item No.9.15: Considering increase in semester examination fee by Rs.500/for Academic Session 2020-21.

The Academic Council after detailed discussions, considering the expenses incurred on the examination system, have approved the proposal to increase the semester examination fee by Rs.500/- for Academic Session 2020-21. As such, Examination Fee of Rs. 2500/- per semester will be chargeable from next academic session beginning with the Pavas Semester Examination 2020 to be held in Dec. 2020.

However, the semester fee for concurrent courses shall be 60%, i.e., Rs.1500/-per semester.

# Item No.9.16.2: Introduction of a New Course of B. Voc. in Civil Aviation and Tourism

The Academic Council noted that affiliation in courses under Faculty of Aerospace and Aviation was not approved in Academic Session due to lack of feasibility of Practical and On-job training. The matter has been reconsidered in view of the proposal submitted by AHA.

After discussions, it was held that the proposal for any course under Faculty of Aerospace and Aviation will be considered only after prospective affiliates provide evidence of tie up of applicant institute with Airport Authority of India and/or with other leading Air Lines of the country like SpiceJet, Indigo, etc. for practical and on-job training of the trainees.

# Item No.No.9.16.3: Affiliation Fee for Specifically Designed Short Term Courses under Skill Credit Certificate Regulations

The Registrar apprised the council that a few affiliated institutes have approached for Specifically Designed Skill Credit Certificate Courses of Credit Value from two (02) to twelve (12) credits when the same have been approved by the concerned Board of Studies. A decision is required for Affiliation fee.

The Academic Council approved the suggestion of Registrar that Affiliation Fee at the rate of Rs.2000/- per credit with maximum of Rs.25,000/- be charged for a specially designed skill credit certificate courses for every run.

Taking a holistic view of the present scenario, UGC Guidelines, Special Nature and requirements of a Skill University and keeping in mind the fact that educational institutions will be required to follow social distancing for some more time even after the Lockdown is lifted, the Academic Council of Rajasthan ILD Skills University, Jaipur makes the following recommendations through approval by E-mails/ Mobile; Provided that the necessary amendments in Regulations wherever essential will be assumed to be approved and Vice-Chancellor is authorised to amend or append the same based on these recommendations.

- 1. Academic Council noted that University is already having Six days week and so will continue with it as such.
- 2. The Academic Council recommends the following revised Academic calendar for the academic session: 2019-2020 based on existing UGC Guidelines.

- 3. Regarding the requirement of minimum percentage of attendance for the students, the period of Lockdown may be treated as 'deemed to be attended' by all the students. Academic Council put on record appreciation of the Affiliated Colleges who started Online Teaching to the extent possible right from the beginning of Lockdown.
- 4. Examinations: University will tentatively conduct Basant 2020 Examination in July and Pavas 2020 in Jan. 2021. Basant 2021 will be conducted in June 2021. University shall follow existing CBCS Regulations with modified Scheme of Examinations as per Board of Studies recommendation as and when given (reducing to two third of existing in case of theory examination) with reduction in theory paper examination duration to 2 hours in place of three hours for Basant 2020 and Pavas 2020 Examinations. No reduction in timings of Practical and Self examination will be given in light of importance of skill training except wherever specifically recommended by Board of Studies. Board of Studies shall hold the meeting through electronic means (videoconferencing, teleconferencing, or e-mail circulation) and forward the recommendations to the University. For Practical and Self-examination ,Video Conferencing Solution may be used to the extent possible for the particular examination . Social Distancing Guidelines in Theory, Practical and Self Examination will be strictly adhered to. Wearing mask and maintaining social distancing will be binding on all students, faculty and staff. Affiliated Colleges and University will take measures of sanitization of their premises, thermal scanning of all, proper hand wash facilities and record of every one visiting premises. The Aarogya Setu App must be downloaded by all students, staff, faculty and visitors.
- 5. The students will be allowed to improve their grades by offering one additional opportunity to appear in the Basant 2021 Examination in papers in which they have been registered for Basant 2020 Examination. Similar provision of improvement of Pavas 2020 Examinations in Pavas 2021 examination will be permitted. There is sufficient flexibility available in CBCS regulations and affiliated colleges must make students aware about provisions of the CBCS regulations.
- 6. In the prevailing circumstances, as desired by the UGC, the affiliated college may adopt appropriate strategies to facilitate the pursuing Projects/ Dissertations. These students may be assigned review-based/ secondary data based projects or software-driven projects, instead of laboratory-based experiments or field/ survey-based assignments, wherever feasible based on recommendation of Board of Studies.
- 7. The affiliated colleges may conduct the practical examinations and Viva- Voce through Skype or other meeting apps wherever permitted by Board of Studies. A video recording will have to be made and kept for record.
- 8. The affiliated college shall make admissions to the various academic programmes for the session 2020-21, latest by 30.09.2020. If necessary, provisional admissions may be made and the last date of submission of relevant documents of qualifying examination will be 15.10.2020.

9. The Academic Session: 2020-21 shall commence from 1.8.2020/ 1.09.2020 for old/fresh students. Accordingly, the Committee recommends following Academic Calendar for the session 2020—21:

- 10. Vice-Chancellor is authorized to constitute a sub-committee of Academic council for framing guidelines for Social Distancing in conduct of Theory/ Practical classes for session 2020-21.
- 11. The affiliate colleges will record the Travel/ Stay history of the staff and students for the period when they remained away from the college due to Lockdown so that necessary precautions may be taken in specific cases, if required. In addition to that, the affiliated colleges shall strictly comply with all precautions and preventive measures to curb the spread of Corona Virus and all guidelines issued by Government or Local Administration.
- 12. In view of the importance of social distancing, Board of Studies may suggest necessary steps regarding exposure to laboratory assignments/ practical experiments through virtual laboratories, sharing of the recorded visuals of laboratory work and digital resources available for the purpose, wherever feasible.
- 13. In order to overcome such challenges in future, affiliated colleges shall train faculty and students on their own for the use of ICT and online teaching tools, so that they complete about 25% of the syllabus through online and 75% syllabus through face to face teaching.
- 14. Every affiliated college should develop virtual classroom and video conferencing facility. All teaching staff should be trained with the use of the technology. Affiliated college should prepare e-content/e-lab experiments and upload the same on their websites for use of their students.
- 15. The Affiliated College should strengthen the mechanism of mentor-mentee counselling through a dedicated portal on college website to impart timely guidance and counselling to the

students. Besides, the faculty advisors and supervisors assigned to each student should maintain regular communication with the students.

- 16. In case of affiliated colleges located at the places where the Government (Centre/State) has imposed restrictions on gathering of public, the recommendations of the Academic Council shall not cause any restrictions on the guidelines/directions issued by the appropriate Government/competent authority.
- 17. Notwithstanding the recommendations of the resumption of session, conduct of examinations and session, every university/ college has to ensure that it is prepared in all respects to carry out the academic activities following necessary advisories/guidelines/directions issued by the Central /State Government/MHRD or UGC from time to time to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

In Re To: My pending request for recognising my right and accordingly granting me the permission to appear in the written exams and juries, as and when these are held.

Reference: My application to Indian Institute of Crafts & Design, Jaipur, vide e-mail dated 23.09.2020 which has been forwarded to RISU by Ms. Toolika Gupta, director IICD, along with her recommendations.

To briefly state my case, I submit as under:

- 1. I was admitted to IICD, Jaipur in the 1st adademic year that commenced in 2019. Thereafter, I stayed in the Institute's hostel, regularly attended all the modules & classes in the 1st semester, and submitted the assignments in a timely/prompt manner.
- 2. I appeared in all the written exams as well as juries, and passed with good marks.
- 3. I similarly continued studying during the 2nd semester, attended all the modules and performed well in my class as per the internal assessments of my submissions.
- Due to COVID-19 pandemic, the Institute had to be closed in March 2020 and online classes were held. Written exams and juries for the 2nd semester could not be held as circumstances did not permit the same.
- RISU directed promotion of all the students to next academic year, and I thus became a student of 2nd year.
- 6. I paid the fees for the 3rd semester (1st semester of 2nd year), and kept on attending online classes as well as continued making online submissions from my home.
- 7. During this time, I gained lateral entry in to 2nd year at Srishti Institute of Art, Design & Technology, Bengaluru (Srishti) which is affiliated to Bangalore Central University, Bengaluru.
- 8. As was required by Srishti, I had to apply for all the transfer related documents, out of which RISU issued the migration certificate and counter signed 1st semester marks' sheet.
- After this, I learnt from Sh. PM Tripathi Ji (Controller of Examinations, RISU) that since I shall not be on the rolls of RISU, rules would not allow me to appear in written exams and juries for the 2nd semester of 1st year, at the time these are held.
- 10. My humble submission is that this is an extraordinary situation and I understand that one cannot expect the existing rules to contain provisions to deal with such an unprecedented situation, since authorities could not have envisaged such a possibility to arise and make suitable provisions at the time of framing the rules.
- 11. Had the COVID-19 pandemic not happened, the exams and juries would have been held at the normal time.
- 12. That no one can be held responsible for these extraordinary circumstances which call for taking equally extraordinary decisions, keeping, in view the critical aspect of this matter as well as severe implications it entails on my future academic carrier.

13. It needs to be kept in mind that the exams and juries in question RELATE TO THE PERIOD I WAS A STUDENT OF IICD AND ON ROLLS OF RISU AND NOT FOR A PERIOD AFTER THE DATE MY MIGRATION CERTIFICATE WAS ISSUED BY RISU. THIS WILL ENABLE ME TO GET THE MARKS SHEET FOR 2ND SEMESTER AS WELL AS CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF 1st YEAR.

14. It is also submitted that should circumstances ultimately do not permit the written exams and juries to be held. I should be issued CFPD certificate and 2nd semester marks sheet based on the internal assessments forwarded to RISU by the Institute.

### Addendum for Chapter- III of Regulations

To consider under power vested in the academic council under section 14 sub section 3(vi) to add regulation R-169 to 172 regarding revaluation of answer books in chapter III regulations for choice-based credit system, is as under

R- 169: Revaluation of answer books shall be permissible in not more than 50% of the theory papers in which candidate actually appeared at an examination. Where the number of papers in which a candidate appeared at an examination happens to be an odd number, evaluation is permitted up to whole number i.e., if an examination consists of 5 papers, the candidate can apply for revaluation of answer books up to 3 papers. Notwithstanding the aforesaid provisions, revaluation of answer books shall not be permitted in respect of the scripts of practical examinations/Self Jury examination / Dissertation, Thesis and viva-voce and continuous assessment

R-170: A candidate who wishes to apply for revaluation of his answer-books(s) must apply in the prescribed form together with the requisite fee within 30 days of declaration of result. Application not received in the prescribed form or by the due date or without the required fee shall be rejected. Incomplete application forms will also be rejected.

R-171: After re-evaluation the result will be worked out as under on the basis of difference in marks.

(i) upto 10 No change

(ii) 10< <20 Revaluation Marks

(iii) 20> The answer book shall be referred to Third examiner and average of the two closest award.

(iv) Notwithstanding above a student which has been declared with grade 'P' even if after re-evaluation marks declared to grade 'F' the result will not be change.

R-172: Once applied for re-evaluation the grade-sheet will stand in abeyance, the new will be issued through affiliate on submission of old. The answer book(s) shall not be subjected to any Inspection or production before any External or Internal authority except at the instance of the Vice-Chancellor. There will be no provision of retotaling, as on Screen Marking evolve automatic calculation subsequent entries for all questions.
